HURRICANE PREPAREDNESS INFORMATION FOR YOUR HOME

- The windows in your home are hurricane rated for up to 140 miles per hour winds. Please secure your windows, making sure they are in the down position and locked.
- Be sure to securely shut all doors, also be sure the front storm door is closed and latched to prevent wind damage.
- If you have a double garage door, there is a locking brace to reinforce it. It is located on the inside of your garage door. Simply place the brace in the middle of your garage door to secure the center of the door from wind damage. Remember to remove garage door locking brace before opening with garage remote.
- If you notice any loose gutters or siding on your home, please call Maintenance and report the issue.
- Unplug any computers or TVs if evacuating. Do not unplug any appliances.
- Power or water shut offs are NOT to be shut off by residents.
- Top off gasoline tanks in your vehicles prior to a storm.
- Items left outside of the home can become airborne during a storm and can become a flying projectile. All exterior items should be stored in the garage and not left outside:
- 1. Outdoor furniture
- 2. Potted plants
- 3. Children's toys, swimming pool toys
- 4. Trash cans and recycle bins
- 5. Trampolines

- 6. Any trash outside the home
- 7. Pet toys or dog chains
- 8. Wind chimes or decorations
- 9. Water hoses or sprinklers
- 10. Barbecue grills
