Grounds Maintenance

The NMO will regularly mow and maintain all unfenced grounds around the Premises including common areas, community centers, and playgrounds. Yards that are not kept free of toys, trash, abandoned items, or debris will not be mowed, trimmed, or edged. Mowing, raking, and trimming of shrubs and other routine maintenance in fenced backyards are the Resident's responsibility. Grass should be maintained at a height of two inches, not to exceed five inches. Raking of grass and leaves is to be done as necessary to maintain a healthy and attractive lawn. Shrubs are to be trimmed to maintain their shape and not block windows, doors, sidewalks, or parking areas.
