TRASH SCHEDULE

**Due to the Labor Day holiday, Bayridge and Sandhill Landings trash day will be Tuesday, September 2nd, and East & West Falcon, and Thrower Parks trash day will be Wednesday, September 3rd.
The schedule will return to normal the following week.

Mondays - Bayridge and Sandhill Landing **Tuesdays** - East & West Falcon and Thrower Park

Trash cans can be placed at the curb the night before your designated pick-up day and should be returned to their appropriate storage location by the end of the day. Ensure that all trash is bagged, securely tied, and fits inside the can.

Bulk Trash - Since some residents are moving in or are getting ready to PCS to their next duty station, we thought it would be beneficial for all to share information on bulk trash and what to do with your empty moving boxes. If you have any large or gently used items to dispose of, consider donating to a local thrift store.

- Sandhill Landing September 2nd (First Tuesday of every month)
- East & West Falcon September 9th (Second Tuesday of every month)
- Thrower Park -September 16th (Third Tuesday of every month)
- Bay Ridge September 23rd (Fourth Tuesday of every month)

 have an emergency or urgent work order, please contact the
 maintenance department any time, day or night, by calling (228)

 687-9969 and pressing 1.
- If you have questions about an open work order, please call our office at (910) 756-3511 and press 2 during regular office hours for updates. Please note: If a duplicate work order is placed, and the first one has not been completed, the new request will be cancelled and will merge with the original request.



We work hard to complete all work orders promptly. If you have questions about open or recently completed requests, please contact our office.

Reminder: Please change your HVAC filter every 30 days (even during winter months). To do so, you can either submit a work order or pick the filter up at self-help. Contact your Community Center at (228) 687-9969 if you have any questions..
