Hurricane Preparedness Quick Reminders

- Build your emergency kit: water, food, meds, flashlights, batteries, important documents, pet supplies.
- Know evacuation procedures: follow Wing Commander orders; plan where you'll go ahead of time.
- Secure or bring in outdoor items: bring furniture, toys, grills, trampolines, and loose items.
- Prep your home: lock windows, remove hoses, clear drains, park away from trees.
- Charge devices: phones, power banks, and emergency alerts.
- Don't forget your pets: carriers, food, records, comfort items.
- Stay informed: follow base updates, local news, and NHC alerts.
- After the storm: avoid down lines, report damages, keep kids/pets away from debris.

MAINTENANCE TIPS

June Maintenance Quick Tips

- Support your cooling system: replace filters, keep vents open, set a steady temp.
- Prep for early hurricane season: review your plan, check your kit, secure outdoor items.
- Prevent summer pests: seal food, cover trash, and avoid leaving pet food outside.
- Check doors & windows: ensure locks work and seals aren't loose.
- Tidy outdoor areas: clear debris, trim overgrowth, keep walkways open.
- Practice grill safety: keep grills 10 ft from the home and never leave them unattended.
- Do a quick safety check: test smoke alarms and confirm extinguishers are accessible.

TRASH SCHEDULE & EVENTS

COMMUNITY TRASH SCHEDULE

Monday: Bayridge and Sand Hill Landing: Trash cans may be placed on the curb Sunday night and must be returned to their proper storage area Monday night. Trash must be bagged, tied, and fit inside the can.

Tuesday: East & West Falcon, Thrower Park: Trash cans may be placed on the curb Monday night and must be returned to their proper storage area Tuesday night. Trash must be bagged, tied, and fit inside the can.

Resident Guidelines: According to the resident guidelines, residents should promptly remove empty trash containers from the curbside to their designated location after collection, no later than the same day as pickup. 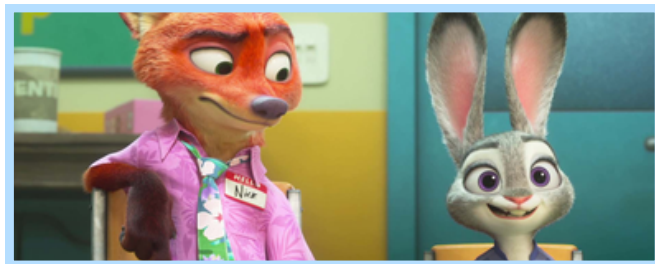
ICE CREAM SOCIAL
