## Manager's Corner

### Are you Prepared for Hurricane Season? Basic Supply List:

- Flashlight/Batteries
  - Battery operated Radio with extra batteries
  - Water – at least 1 gallon daily per person for 3 to 7 days
    - Food – enough for 3 to 7 days
      - Non-electric can opener
    - Non-perishable and canned foods
      - Food for infants or elderly
        - Snack foods
      - Cooking tools, fuel
  - Paper plates, roll of paper towels, plastic utensils
    - Blankets, Pillows
  - Clothing – seasonal, raingear, sturdy shoes
  - First Aid kit, Prescription Medicines
    - Toiletries
      - Cash
      - Keys
      - Tools
  - Important Documents (keep in a waterproof container)
    - Special needs for Infants or Elderly
  - Pet Care Items (food, water, carrier/cage, medicines)

## Maintenance

### Helpful Maintenance Tips to Follow:

#### EXCESS MOISTURE

Since mold thrives in moist environments, it is important to prevent Excessive moisture buildup in your home. Failure to promptly report leaks or remove moisture buildup on home surfaces can encourage mold growth. Common sources of excess moisture include:

- Air conditioning set too low, creating condensation on windows
  - Leaving windows open with the air conditioning on
  - Rainwater leaking from roofs, windows, doors, outside walls or the foundation.
  - Overflows from showers, bathtubs, toilets, lavatories, sinks, washing machines, dehumidifiers or refrigerators
  - Leaks from plumbing lines, fixtures or dryer discharge vents
  - Not properly ventilating bathrooms, kitchens and laundry rooms
  - Steam-cleaning carpets and not extracting most of the water
  - Spills on soft surfaces that are not cleaned immediately to include plant-watering overflows, pet urine, cooking spills and beverage spills
  - Wet towels or laundry left on floors or carpets
  - Overflowing air conditioning drip pans or condensation lines
- Immediately notify your maintenance team.

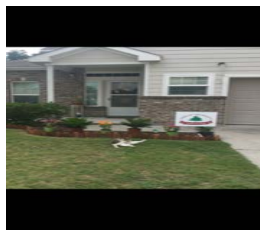

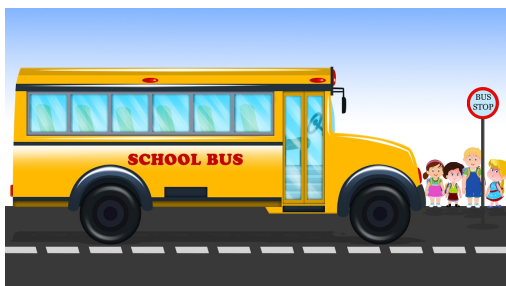
